



Transferring from the CIPS Level 5 Advanced Diploma in Procurement and Supply (2013 to 2018 syllabus)

Any CIPS students who have passed exams (or been awarded exemptions from exams) based upon the CIPS Level 5 Advanced Diploma in Procurement and Supply (2013 syllabus), will be given credits for modules within the updated 2018 syllabus. This ensures that students are not disadvantaged by any changes to the syllabus. See the table below:
