

APPENDIX I

Learners who successfully complete the Hong Kong Polytechnic University – Bachelor of Business Administration (Honours) in Global Supply Chain Management in accordance with the conditions listed below may apply for direct entry to the CIPS Advanced Diploma in Procurement and Supply, without having to complete the CIPS Diploma in Procurement and Supply. However, learners are NOT eligible to be awarded certification for the CIPS Diploma in Procurement and Supply.

The following conditions are to be applied to this accreditation:

1. The following modules from the Bachelor of Business Administration (Hons) in Global Supply Chain Management must be passed:
 - a. AF2108 Financial Accounting
 - b. LGT3001 Logistics and Distribution Management
 - c. AF2110 Management Accounting 1
 - d. LGT4110 Purchasing Management
 - e. LGT4106 Supply Chain Management
 - f. MM4311 Strategic Management

2. LGT4114 'Supplier Development and Contract Management' must be selected as one of the Specialist Electives in either Year 3 or Year 4.

3. MM4191 'Business Negotiation' must be selected as one of the Free Electives in either Year 3 or Year 4.

4. All modules referred to above must be passed, without any form of credit transfer, advanced standing, condonement or compensation.

The period of accreditation is to be from September 2019 to August 2020.

Applications for direct entry must be received within five years of the date of issue of the degree certificate, and documentary evidence (i.e. transcript and certificate) supporting the above conditions must be provided to CIPS.
