Learners can submit their BTEC certificate, with a payment of £12.00 to CIPS and they will be awarded an exemption for 2013 Syllabus Unit D1 Contexts of Procurement and Supply or 2018 Syllabus Unit L4M1 Scope and Influence of Procurement and Supply which is part of the CIPS Diploma in procurement and supply (Level 4) programme, this will enable learners to progress and study the remaining units to achieve the full award (5 units in total), CIPS Diploma in procurement and supply (Level

- 4) is an entry point on the CIPS Qualifications ladder providing professional qualifications and progression opportunities for aspiring procurement and supply professionals
